INTRODUCTION

The words used to describe Christians today often bear no resemblance to the one-word Jesus wanted His followers to be known. What would it look like if we got it right? What if we as Christians embodied this one word? What if our behavior was so consistent with this word folks around us were drawn to us and therefore to God. The one word is love.

- Why did you feel this way?

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GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Have you ever had a moment where you felt like you had to "qualify" you were a Christian?

- 3. Tell of a time when you showed love to someone who didn't deserve it. Why did you show love in that situation and how did the person respond?
- 4. Read aloud **Leviticus 19:18.** What did Jesus add to this command that makes it new? What does Jesus say that qualifies or defines the type of love He is commanding His disciples to have?
- 5. Read aloud 1 John 4:19. What does it mean that we love Him because He first loved us?

- 6. What would true Christian love (as disciples) look like if Jesus' example was truly followed? How can you follow the example of love He displayed on the cross?
- 7. What are some of the costs of Christians being more concerned with following rules than loving others? How might it influence the way non-church people view God?
- 8. Read **Matthew 25:35–40**. In what ways does this passage demonstrate the "love" we are to show others as a Christian?
